Centrifuge and Plant Operator – Glasgow

Job description

The primary duties of the position include skilled operation of a centrifuge plant and waste water treatment works. The candidate will need to manage the control of the plant, adjustment of running parameters, fault check, and proactively comply with CAR licence and Waste Management Licence.

Co-ordination with the existing process department and maintenance team as well as adopting safe working techniques and good overall operation practices are key.

Key duties

- Operate Sludge Management Centre including Centrifuge, Centrifuge feed and associated chemical dosage plant and Odour Control.
- Carry out daily, weekly and monthly tasks throughout the Waste Water Treatment Works.
- React appropriately to anomalies, failure or breakdown of equipment
- Ensure compliance with relevant standards and legislation.
- Be able to solve problems by properly investigating symptoms and tracing back to identify root cause.
- Suggestion of solutions for continuous improvement of plant safety, reliability, and overall efficiency.

Knowledge and skills required

- Committed and self-motivated, with very good interpersonal skills.
- Experience working in a similar role or position is required, or freshly graduated from Water School.
- Good working knowledge of pneumatic and hydraulic systems from an operator's perspective.
- Strong understanding and appreciation of the need for safe systems of work, including risk assessment and method statements, isolation procedures and permit to work systems.

- Ability to use hand held computerised equipment.
- Strong oral and written communications skills in English.
- Demonstrated ability for independent decision-making.
- Must be flexible and responsive to the needs of the business.
- Current driving licence.
- Good understanding of automated/PLC controlled equipment is beneficial.
- Experience and knowledge of the Water/Wastewater industry is a bonus.
- A current forklift license is beneficial.
- Current certificate for competency in confined spaces and escape BA beneficial.

Day and Night shifts will be required from time to time. The core working week is 37hrs Monday to Saturday. However, the successful applicant shall be available to work additional hours as and when required due to plant operational needs, and to participate within a Standby Call-Out rota.
